### **The Hon Justice Arnold, Court of Appeal, Wellington**

Having taught at law schools in Canada and New Zealand, Justice Arnold joined Chapman Tripp in 1982 and was a partner from 1985-1994. In 1994 he became a barrister sole and was appointed Queen's Counsel in 1997. In 2000 Justice Arnold became Solicitor-General and in 2006 he was appointed to the Court of Appeal. He has taught, written and presented seminars in a variety of areas and has been active in the development of skills-based training for litigators.



### **Jack Hodder QC, Chapman Tripp, Wellington**

Jack is the senior litigation partner, and National Board Chair, at Chapman Tripp. He practises nationally, providing advice and representation in all aspects of corporate, commercial and public law. He was appointed Senior Counsel in 2008.
