
Professor Rob Merkin QC, Duncan Cotterill

Rob is the Lloyd's Professor of Law at the University of Exeter (UK). He also teaches the LLM in Insurance Law at the University of Auckland. Rob is a past president of the British Insurance Law Association, and an honorary life president of the International Insurance Law Association. He served as a consultant to the English and Scottish Law Commissions for their project on insurance law reform in 2006-2016; and in 2014 he acted as Special Adviser to the House of Lords Special Public Bills Committee on the Insurance Bill (now Act). In 2015, Rob was made a QC honoris causa. As a member of Duncan Cotterill's insurance law team, he advises insurers and brokers on insurance law issues. Rob is a regular speaker at insurance industry events and conferences worldwide; and he sits as an arbitrator in insurance disputes. He has written a number of leading texts on insurance law, including *Colinvaux's Law of Insurance in New Zealand* (2nd edition, December 2017).
