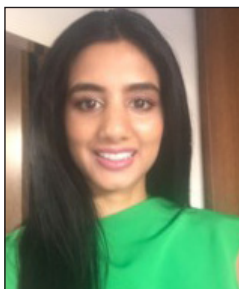


## PRESENTERS
