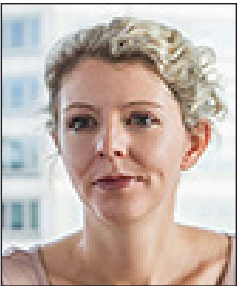


PRESENTERS
