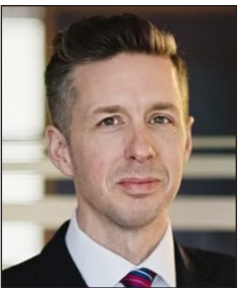


PRESENTERS
