His Hon Chief Judge Graeme Colgan, Employment Court, Auckland

Chief Judge Colgan was admitted to the Bar in 1976 and practised as a litigation lawyer until 1987 when he went to the independent bar in Auckland. He was appointed as a judge of the Labour Court in 1989 which became the Employment Court in 1991. He was appointed as Chief Judge in 2005. Chief Judge Colgan has practised employment law under four distinct statutory regimes.
