She joined WorkSafe shortly after it was set up as the Health and Safety Regulator for New Zealand, following the need for change after the Pike River tragedy. Sue has been involved in and overseen the prosecution of many cases under the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992 and the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015. Prior to this, she was a Crown Prosecutor at Meredith Connell (the Crown Solicitor's Office, Auckland), taking a range of diverse criminal matters to trial. Sue started off her working life as a scientist, and regularly appeared in court as an expert witness in forensic science.
