Kia ora whānau,

I want to continue this week in a positive light and focus on all the activities that have come on line in the last two weeks.

School life and participation:

- School sports have become active and it is great to see all the different teams preparing for games next term. Netball has three teams: College Senior, College Development and a Junior Development team. Rugby is putting two teams forward, an Under 13s and Under 16s team into the mix. We have a Junior Football team in partnership with Piopio Primary School. We have a Junior Hockey team and a Social Basketball team as well as students playing squash at Aria.
- The senior girls are leading the “This is Me” activity program for female students and also some senior student leaders running lunchtime sports activities for students as well as where sport competitions.
- The leadership team and staff want to thank all the managers, coordinators, coaches assistants volunteers and supporters of their teams for their dedication and commitment to our school life and sports teams.
- We are planning a fun celebration day on the last Friday of term to celebrate Matariki and post Lockdown Return to school for all our students. This day will culminate in a variety show organised by the juniors after lunch and if you want to join us please contact the front office for more information.

Attendance and engagement:

- Just a friendly reminder to ensure where possible, students under the age of 16 attend school unless they are unable to, due to legitimate reasons as we are now out of lockdown. We are attempting to support all students to meet their needs to succeed and encourage parents and whānau to talk to us about your children's needs.
- Classrooms and cell phones are not the best of partners as cell phones tend to isolate students from what they need to do in class as students focus on their social interactions rather than school work, and take their focus away from learning tasks. Hence the school policy is that students need to make sure that the cell phones are not active or out when they arrive at their classes. Teachers have been asked to ensure that students understand the importance of engaging in real time as opposed to focussing on the virtual online life and weneed your help in this matter and would appreciate it if parents were able to talk to students about their cell phones.
- I also want to introduce parents, employers and senior students who do work experience either through gateway and other employment partnership, to a free app known as Endorseme®. This app enables employers and supervisors to endorse students online in the skills and competencies that students display at work. 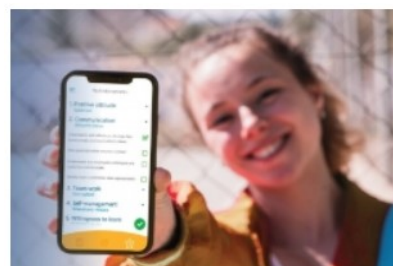
