## Champs with point to prove

Surely not that much has changed in the past 12 months.

Mt Albert Ramblers coach Venita Hokai shakes her head and tries to understand how her defending open women's club champions have slipped to third seeds for this year's tournament, which begins today at Lower Hutt's Fraser Park.

Western Magpies – the Auckland club champions –



have been installed as favourites, with runners-up Otahuhu in second and then Ramblers.



Nothing much has separated those three clubs and fourth-ranked Waitakere Bears – beaten by Ramblers in last year's final – all season, but the titleholders are feeling a tad unloved at their slide down the rankings.

That can only mean bad news for their rivals.

"I think it's pretty much open to anybody from Auckland," says Hokai, who stepped down from the day-to-day coaching role this season to concentrate on her Junior White Sox duties. She has taken up the reins this week to allow player/ coach Tuhi Cooper to focus on her playing role.

"I think an Auckland team will win it. We probably should have been seeded one or two – I don't see how we could drop from first to third."

Hokai reasons that the weekly Auckland competition is no real guide to tournament form and with four strong pitchers, she's confident her team is better equipped than most for this format.

The Ramblers battery is spearheaded by Michal Tangaroa – daughter of Black Sox pitching legend Chubb – who named top pitcher last year, while playing for the Bears.

"We have a pretty decent pitching staff compared to the other teams, so we'll be tough on the mound," says Hokai. "We're not as experienced as last year, especially in the outfield, and I don't
